Monday, Sept. 1: A friend of the Ka'apana 'ohana reports that at 2:30 this afternoon, Ledward Ka'apana and his Ibanez guitar were reunited. No further details were available.

Search on for Ledward Ka'apana's missing guitar

On Mon., Aug. 25, Ledward Ka'apana and his sister, Lehua, went to play for Peter Moon's birthday with family in tow. On the way home they stopped at Likelike Drive Inn for a bite to eat.

While inside, someone stole Ka'apana's Ibanez guitar from his car. One of the back car doors may not have been closed enough for the lock to engage. There was no sign of forced entry.
